# **Volunteer and Outreach Coordinator**

The Lao Conservation Trust for Wildlife is a Lao registered non-profit that works as an all-inclusive species rescue, education, and conservation center in Lao PDR. As a Lao registered foundation, we work to conserve Lao biodiversity by continually working with Lao government authorities on wildlife rescues, professional training, and monetary support.

On-site we house around 250 animals, native to Southeast Asia of varying taxa including large mammals such as bears, a variety of primates, ungulates, reptiles, birds, and small mammals.

LCTW is committed to conservation on both a regional and global scale working alongside other wildlife organizations to aid in biodiversity conservation efforts. Our tours and education programs utilize our unique placement in Laos to provide access to knowledge for Lao people about how they can help to conserve Laos' incredible biodiversity.

#### The Role

The role of Volunteer and Outreach Coordinator (V&O Coordinator) will be multi-faceted and the perfect fit for someone who has a passion for environmental storytelling, experience working with volunteers and interns and a proven track-record executing nonprofit education and outreach, including fundraising. Listed below are the perceived responsibilities of the V&O Coordinator, however, it should be noted that not all these programs are expected to be implemented immediately. However, the chosen candidate should work towards setting them up according to the Center and community's needs.

- International Volunteer Program: Managing and continually improving our international volunteer program. These duties will include managing volunteer bookings, corresponding with prospective volunteers, contacting new volunteer partners, universities, and travel companies. Once volunteers arrive at the center it will be the coordinator's responsibility to ensure they are comfortable and settle in well with the team they will be directly working with during their volunteer/internship period. The coordinator will also help to organize activities or events that volunteers can participate in, such as local cultural exchanges.
- Local Volunteer Program: Manage and expand a volunteer program for expats and Lao people who would like to donate their time to helping the center.
- **Social Media Manager:** Develop and create content, organize existing content, and assist the Director in managing our social media pages (Facebook, Instagram, TikTok).
- University Internship Program: Design and implement an internship program for local university students or recent graduates who are interested in getting experience in any one of the fields represented here at LCTW (conservation, illegal wildlife trade, accounting, wildlife care, etc.)
- Local School Outreach Program: Develop positive relationship with local schools near the center and deliver the already developed curriculum for monthly school lessons.
- Tour Guide: Provide tours to guests and ensure the tour information is educational and exciting for the guests.
- Fundraising and Grants: Assist the Director with sourcing, writing/applying for, and managing reporting for
  existing grants. This includes researching individuals, corporations, and foundations that are interested in gift
  giving. Strategize and successfully execute fundraising campaigns and events.
